Join NII Explore for a fun and exciting summer of hands-on learning for students of all ages as we dive into the topics of STEM - Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math!



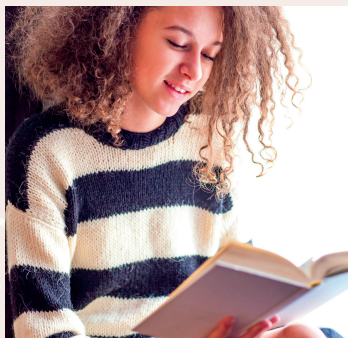
## Story Time
