## How does beanstack work?

Sign in, and you'll be taken to a screen showing current challenges.

Press 'Return to Program' to enter one you've already registered for, and press the purple 'Register' button to join a challenge.

### Logging your reading

Press the '**Log Reading and Activities**' button to track your reading. Some challenges track time spent reading, others track books completed.

Reaching milestones for time or titles read will unlock badges unique to that program. Complete all the requirements to earn the completion badge!

Whole family wants in? Beanstack lets you create one account with multiple 'readers' in it — each one can be a different family member.

During registration you'll be asked if you want to add others. Add as many adults and children as you like.
