On behalf of the Board, I am pleased to endorse the 2022 Annual Report of the Bruce County Public Library (BCPL).

In 2022, BCPL made significant strides implementing their strategic priorities. As a Trusted Community Connector, staff attended several outreach events including Fall Fairs, Toucha-Truck, and the Grey-Bruce One World Festival. New Resident packages are now available at all 17 branches, ensuring that those new to our communities can easily access important local information. While supply chain difficulties impacted our ability to launch the Bookmobile, staff have been hard at work behind the scenes to ensure it can quickly begin providing service once it is received.

Recognizing the increase in remote work, several of our branches now offer digitally equipped spaces available to those looking for an alternate work location. As a Digital Community Facilitator, we also provide technology assistance and instruction. We appreciate the donation from NPX that allowed us to update our iPads to continue providing this service.

As a Community Sharing Place, we now have a Local Author Collection and a Borrow by Mail Service. BCPL offers a wealth of items to borrow beyond books, including technology kits, binoculars, and fishing rods. On behalf of the Library Board and Staff I invite you to join the library and discover all that BCPL has to offer.

We had two notably successful community programs this year: Food for Fines, which brought in 634 items for local food banks, and Summer Reading Club, which saw its most successful year ever with a combined total of 217,570 minutes read!

COLLECTIONS

BCPL worked throughout 2022, diversifying our collection. By identifying titles that fall under the eight selected Diversity, Equity and Inclusion (DEI) topics, we were able to bring in relevant, interesting and informative materials to all our Bruce County patrons. PROGRAMMING

Workshops for seniors. These workshops branched into our now regular program, Tech Coach. We created a space where small groups can get one-onone assistance that provides the building blocks for digital learning.
